From delivery captain, Damian Likely, MSc; who on Sept. 13th completed the trans-Atlantic delivery of a Fountaine Pajot 43, Belize: "Compared to other catamarans that I have delivered, and especially compared to the Lagoon line, the Fountaine-Pajot Belize 43 is more responsive, points better and is much quicker to accelerate. The forward steering station is much preferred and the Fountaine Pajot station is much easier to work from than that on the Lagoon. I encountered very, very heavy seas during this trip and nothing has broken and no stress cracks were seen--that has not been the case on other catamaran deliveries. Also, on the



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Lagoon, they seem to glue all the pieces together, like some of the mass produced monohulls, and so when we did need to get access to components it was very difficult. On the Fountaine Pajot, we checked this and even though we didn't have to get to anything, it would have been very much easier. I used to be prejudiced against catamarans and preferred monohulls but, after the Fountaine Pajot delivery—I have definitely been converted! ”
